

Privacy Policy

Blackpalfrey Motor Club of Kent (The Club) holds personal data about its members. This data is used to process your membership, and provide you with information from The Club, to enable the carrying out of our membership activities.

Data protection notice

The Club collects and maintains personal information so that it can carry out its functions as a Motor Club, provide membership services and comply with statutory requirements as necessary.

The Club treats all personal information with complete confidentiality and with appropriate levels of security. By joining the Club, you agree to our processing your personal information for the purposes outlined below.

The personal data will be used for a range of club-based activities relating to its running. These include the maintenance of records, promotion of events and requests for members to help in the running of events.

All information relating to an individual will be kept throughout the individual's time as a member and for such reasonable period (and to the extent necessary) after membership as may be needed.

Personal data will only be available to these specific officers of The Club, Secretary, Membership Officer, Treasurer, Chairman, Press and Publicity Officer, and Webmaster for the purpose of providing member services, publicising Club events, seeking help with the running of Club events and the administration of the Club.

Under the Data Protection Act 1998 The Club members have the right to view the information The Club holds on them and to request correction of any incorrect information held. This can be achieved through personal login access to The Club's membership database.

If members cannot access their details online they can request a copy of the details from The Club's Membership Officer

This notice may be amended from time to time.

The Club membership website takes every precaution to protect our members' information: when personal and sensitive information is submitted via the website it is protected.

The Club does not sell or allow external organisations to use your data. All emails or direct mail pieces such as HIGHWAY magazine are sent to you from the Club. To opt out of email communication log into your membership record and delete your email address.
